

Implementation of the Schemes Announced by Government of India

1. **PG SCHOLARSHIP (GATE/GPAT/CEED)** AICTE in order to ensure development of technical education in India awards Post Graduate Scholarship of Rs. 12,400/- per month to full-time GATE/GPAT/CEED qualified students admitted to AICTE approved post graduate programs in AICTE approved Institutions/ University Departments as per AICTE approved intake. Only GATE/GPAT qualified candidates are eligible for GATE/GPAT scholarship Admissions before or after GATE/GPAT validity shall not be considered for GATE/GPAT scholarship Scholarship is awarded to full time GATE/GPAT qualified students admitted to M.E. / M. Tech / M. Arch and M.Pharma courses in AICTE approved Institutions / Colleges @Rs. 12,400/- PM/ student.
2. **PRIME MINISTERS SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (PMSSS)** J & K Cell deals with Implementation of Prime Ministers Special Scholarship Scheme to J&K Students to pursue undergraduate studies outside the State of Jammu and Kashmir. The J & K cell is responsible for proper implementation of the scheme to fulfil the objectives of Prime Ministers Special Scholarship Scheme to J&K Students.
3. **AICTE – PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR GIRL STUDENTS (DEGREE)** Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing assistance for advancement of Girls pursuing technical education. Education is one of the most important means of empowering women with the knowledge, skill and self-confidence necessary to participate fully in the development process. This is an attempt to give young women the opportunity to further her education and prepare for a successful future by “Empowering Women through Technical Education”. The girl candidate should be admitted to First year of Degree level course OR Second year of Degree level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year. Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP: Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study Applications will be invited once in a year through National e-Scholarship Portal of the Government of India.
4. **SAKSHAM SCHOLARSHIP** Saksham is a MHRD Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing encouragement and support to specially-abled children to pursue technical education. This is an attempt to give every young student, who is otherwise specially-abled, the opportunity to study further and prepare for a successful future through technical education/ knowledge. • Scholarship for Differently Abled Students under SAKSHAM Scheme Implemented by All India Council For Technical Education, New Delhi. ELIGIBILITY • Specially-abled student, having disability of not less than 40%. • Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP: • Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study

5. AICTE has approved 'AICTE – SWANATH SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME' The Scheme is being implemented by AICTE to provide encouragement and support to orphans, wards of parents died due to Covid-19, wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed) to pursue education. This is an attempt to give every such child, an opportunity to study further and prepare for a successful future through education in AICTE Approved institutions and courses.

1. SWANATH SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME for children from any one of the following categories: 1. Orphan 2. Either or both parents died due to Covid-19 3. Wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed) to provide them financial support of Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study.

6. SUPPORT TO STUDENTS FOR PARTICIPATING IN COMPETITION ABROAD (SSPCA) The objective of the scheme is to provide travel assistance registration fees to a team of minimum 2 to 10 students for attending competition at international level in order to encourage engineering students to improve their field of technical education. ELIGIBILITY • (a) Team of Students (2 to 10) in the field of technical education must be enrolled and undergoing a technical course notified by the council in a AICTE approved technical institutions. FINANCIAL SUPPORT • Scheme will provide assistance of Rs. 1.00 Lakh as a package inclusive of all related expenses, to the eligible students as per the scheme without putting any barrier on head of expenditure

7. An “AICTE-INAE Travel Grant Scheme” For Engineering Students The objective of the scheme is to provide partial travel assistance and registration fees to Bachelors and Masters Level engineering students for presenting a research paper in an international scientific event (conference/ seminar/ symposium/ workshop/ exhibition etc) in order to encourage engineering students to engage in research. Please Note: As special case for Covid-19 situation, the financial support towards payment of registration fee (only) is applicable for presenting in online international conferences being held abroad, scheduled between Nov 1, 2020 – Mar 31, 2022.
